#### 1. Title of the Practice:

#### **WOMEN EMPOWERMENT**

#### 2. Objectives of the Practice:

1. To empower women through education and strengthen them with social values and ethical sphere of life.
2. To strive to create a better society by empowering women
3. To create awareness of the woman's rights.
4. To build self-respect and confidence among girl students.
5. To Identify and develop leadership qualities among girl students.
6. To conduct seminars, workshops and different competition for over all academic excellence.
7. To provide scope for creativity in literature.
8. To develop group discussion and presentation skills in students.
9. To practice the concept of an organization for Team Work

#### 3. The Context:

In the ancient Indian society, women were adored and worshiped as goddesses. However in the middle age, the status of women got down to a great extent. Women Empowerment has been an issue of immense discussions and contemplation over the last few decades world-wide. In the history of human development, women has been as

important as man. In fact, empowering women is a prerequisite for creating a good nation and stability of society.

Our institution is exclusively for girl students. Majority of girls are hailing from rural and hilly areas where miserable conditions of poverty, illiteracy, ill-health and superstitions take hold their lives. Thus, they are affected by the educationally backwardness and social discrimination.

Considering all, our institution organised the programs focusing on Women empowerment through academic activities to develop different skills, create awareness about women laws and strengthen them in view of social, educational, economic, political and psychological perspectives.

#### 4. The Practice:

The practices smashed throughout the year and the activities are discussed below.

- **Invited Talk:** The eminent speaker of our college Prof. Dr. Pradnya Vijay Ghorpade had delivered a lecture on 'Ideal Mother' (Adarsh Mata) on occasion of commemoration day of Late Kusumtai Patil (Aaisaheb) on 29.12.2020. The speaker, Dr. Ghorpade emphasized on idealism among the Indian women and their dedication toward family and nation. Principal, faculties and more than 150 students were present.
- **Wall Paper Publication** on theme of 'Women in Freedom Struggle Movement' was inaugurated by Prof. Dr. Pradnya Ghorpade on same day. Several students read articles from this wall paper for about one month.
- **Online Elocution and Essay writing Competition** organised for students. The first three students were felicitated in prize distribution program. There were 12 participants in online Elocution competition and 25 in Essay writing Competition.
- **Celebration of World Womens' Day and Wall Paper Publication:** The invited talk of Prof. Dr. Pratibha Jagtap was organised on 08.3.2021. The chief Guest has inaugurated Wall Paper Issue on "Women Nobel Laureates in English Literature". The literature of Nobel authors like Nadine Gordimer and Tony Morrison was discussed effectively by speaker. The program was organised by Department of English. The program was benefited by around 100 students.

- **Wall Paper Publication on a Law regarding women:** On the occasion of World Womens' Day (08.3.2021), a special issue of Wall paper on 'Laws regarding Women' was published at auspicious hands of Principal Dr. Rajendra Kurlapkar. Many students were benefited by the acquaintance of the Laws made for women's safety and protection.
- **Trilingual Poetry Recitation Program:** On the occasion of World Women's Day (08.3.2021) the Poetry recitation program was organised on 'Womens' issues' for students. Some faculty member of language department and more than 20 students were recited the poems. The program was organised by B. A part-II students under the guidance of Dr. Pradnya Ghorpade and Dr. T. D. Dange.
- **Law Awareness Camp:** Anti-Ragging Committee and Internal Complaint Committee has jointly organised this camp on 9 March 2021. Invited speakers were shared various lawful information with students. The speaker Adv. Rupali Khot , Adv. Manish Vanmore and Adv. A. D. Mali spoken on Patience Plan and Victim Compensation Schemes, Family domestic violence and Dowry prohibition Law, Adv. Anti Ragging Law respectively. The conclusion remark was made by Mr. Ajinkya Kumbhar. Total number of participants in this program was more than 100.

### 5. Evidence of success:

Empowerment is the fundamental right of women. They have equal rights as per constitution to social transformation. For empowerment of women our college conducted several programs to achieve above objectives of this practice. The practices completed with following activities which are organised successfully and students are benefited. The major organization activities were-

**IQAC PRACTICE: 2****1. Title of the Practice:****E-CONTENT DEVELOPMENT****2. Objectives of the Practice:**

1. To promote generation of e-Content in all subjects at college level
2. To develop teachers' intellectual resources in e-Content as per curriculum
3. To make available the E-Content to students through various contemporary ICT modes
4. To provide various learning resources to students through E content
5. To provide teaching- learning platform in Covid -19 pandemic situation during lockdown
6. To maintain easy access of study material to students
7. To conduct practice quizzes through various modes of ICT.
8. To develop the ICT skills among teachers and students.

**3. The Context:**

Electronic content which refers to the content of education delivered over network based electronic devices such as computer or cell phone network. The E-content always attracts attention, enhance understanding and accelerates interest of students in learning. Use of ICT tools minimizes the distance of learning and recommended in daily practices.

Corona virus outbreak brought nationwide shutdown; students across the country were stayed at home after closure of academic institutions. The education is a prime need of human for overall development of individual and nation; therefore, it should be continued even in adverse extremity. The use of Open Educational Resources and E- content development were powerful tool during pandemic situation.

Considering all in view, teachers of our college were encouraged to develop e content as per curriculum and provide it to students regularly. This effort successfully recovered the loss of students during Covid-19 situation.

### 4. The Practice:

The use of ICT in teaching-learning has been implemented since last decades in our institution, but the effective use of ICT and E- content development was a need of time during Covid-19 pandemic. Our teachers were developed many resources of study materials and tried to reach up to each student through various ICT tools. This practice engaged the teachers throughout the year and their efforts are discussed below.

**Audio Visual Video Lectures:** The educational Audio- visual videos are meant to educate the student to relevant topic in an effective way. These videos were recorded in the classroom or home, edited and further processed for effectiveness. Lectures and laboratory experiment demonstrations were recorded in educational video to provide students during pandemic situation. The videos were well documented and considered a valid tool for student education which has provided more personal feel in student-teacher interaction. The majority of videos are consuming less than 20 minutes time. Almost all teachers had prepared Audio-visual lecture videos, uploaded on YouTube and provided link to students. Some of the teachers had sent their videos directly on Whatsapp groups while some started YouTube channel.

**Online Classes:** Majority of the teachers involved in generation of E- content in the form of PPT Presentations, topic notes and illustrations. They conducted online class with the help of Google meet, Zoom, Team link like platforms. The online classes are considered to be most effective and interactive communication method of teaching.

**Google Classroom:** It is a free service by Google for schools, college students and anyone having Google Account. Our college teachers have created google classrooms because it saves time and paper work of teacher and students. It is easy to create classes, distribute assignments, communicate and stay organised. Our teachers added students directly by sharing a code. Our teachers have provided paperless assignments to students and assessed quickly on classroom. Similarly, the class materials like notes, practical manuals and documents were provided to students. The students doubt be cleared through chat window in classroom. Classroom allows teachers to send announcements, notices and discussions instantly.

**Google Quiz and other examination tool:** The continuous assessment is very important in academics. The use of online pedagogical tool for performance assessment and examination can minimize teachers' efforts and time. Our teachers have used Google Quizzes, Google Forms and Textmose app for this purpose during last year.

### 5. Evidence of success:

Almost all the teachers contributed in E-content development for students' progression all time, but the effort has been intentionally made during the pandemic situation. The required sufficient E-content generation was takes place as per curriculum designed by university. We successfully reached to students with modest educational contents in effective ways by using ICT tools.

Use of ICT in teaching learning has been implemented since last decades but effectively used during Covid-19 pandemic. About 71.42% teachers were prepared Audio Visual Video Lectures, 35% teachers conducted Online Classes through Zoom and Meet, 20% teachers operated Google Classroom, 100% faculties were used Google Quizzes, Google Forms for students. Nearly 50% teachers used more than one ICT tool for E content.

Our efforts visualized in positive results of students in university examination conducted during Covid-19 situation.

### 6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required:

Some of the students are hailing from remote and hilly area and having mobile network issues, and some students from poor family background do not afford the computer and mobile at their home. Such students might be less benefited from this practice. But over all we do not encounter serious problem concerning the implementation and operating of this practice in our institution.
