#### 6.2.2 Standing committee report-2020-2021

Introduction-Standing Committee in the college/Institution is broadly related to monitoring, evaluating and planning measures for ensuring effective implementation of the policies of Government of Maharashtra and UGC in respect of reservation to the Backward class community.

In this regard, the Shivaji University, Kolhapur has established/framed the ordinance No-158 for constitution of this committee.

As per the norms put forth by Shivaji University, our college constituted Standing committee for regular execution of policy measures.

- Constitution of committee-
- Chairperson-Principal is the chairperson of the committee, which is the highest authority at the college and monitor all the activities and implementation of norms.
- Two teaching faculty members-Two members from teaching faculty are included in Standing committee who actually involve in teaching process and aware about the student's problem.
- Two Women's Representative- The said committee also includes two women's representatives from teaching faculty.

- Three members from administrative faculty- the other three members from administrative faculty are also included in committee.
- (There shall be adequate representation of Backward class candidates on this committee)

- Responsibilities of Standing committee-
- The committee maintain proper records of the students belonging to backward class, SC/ST/OBC/DT/NT etc.
- The standing committee is required to resolve the issues related to student's admission and scholarships.
- The said committee strictly adhere or insist for implementation of recruitments and promotion of B.C candidates at the college level.
- The committee also make efforts to inform regularly the Govt. schemes related to backward candidates.
- Meetings-
- In the year 2020-2021, two meetings were held on 17/9/2020 and 23/4/2020 respectively for the accurate implementation of such issues regarding caste validity,scholarship forms,Admission and improvement of educational standards of backward class students as well as regarding the awareness of competitive examinations.
- Functions/Powers of the Standing Committee:

The Standing Committee plays vital role in the functioning of the provisions of the Act, ordinances by Shivaji University, Kolhapur and State Govt. as well as ensure fulfilment of the objectives.

The major functions of Standing Committee are-

1. To maintain a roster of teaching and non-teaching staff.
2. To inform the details of vacant posts (nonteaching, teaching) to S.U. and to take review of backlog in nonteaching categories.
3. Timely vigilance to college and hostel admission in accordance with the reservation policy stated or declared by Govt. of Maharashtra.
4. Analysing and approving the advertisement issued by the Management for recruitment.
5. To implement effectively scheme or reservation policy mandatory by the State Govt.
6. Standing committee also ensures proper allotment and distribution of scholarship for the B.C candidates.

In the year 2020-2021, online meeting of Standing Committee was held on 23-04-2020.

**The agenda of the meeting :**

1. To fill online application forms regarding the caste validity by the students.
2. Online submission of forms related with e-scholarship for backward candidates or students. Dr. Gejge guided the students of senior college regarding the details of submission.
